Bring:

- ✓ A **copy** of the birth certificate of each new child registering (not the original)
- ✓ A **wallet size** photograph of each child (non-returnable)
- ✓ A medical approval on the **Official Pop Warner Medical Form** (downloadable from the Panthers website www.claypanthers.org) dated January 1st, 2008 or after, stating that each child is physically able to participate.
- ✓ **Two** copies of a 2008 **final** report card for each child by July 24th, 2008.

**All paper work including report cards must be handed in by paperwork night July 23rd and July 24th. If your child does not have required paper work, he/she will not be allowed to practice until the specified paper work has been turned in. If paperwork is not handed in by August 19th, your child will be dropped from the roster.
